Subject: Renewal of permission for admission of 2nd Batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. 100-150 at School of Medical Sciences & Research, Greater Noida for the academic year 2016-17.

Sir/Madam,

In supersession of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 30.05.2016 am directed to refer to MCI's letter No.MCI-37(I)(RI-91)/2015-Med./108952 dated 14.05.2016 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of the Central Government for renewal of permission for admission of 2nd Batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. 100-150 for the academic year 2016-17 at School of Medical Sciences & Research, Greater Noida under Sharda University, Noida.

2. The permission is valid for one year and for admitting only one batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. 100-150 during the academic session 2016-17. The next batch of students in MBBS course against increased intake will be admitted in the college only after permission of Central Government for renewal/recognition.
3. The Government Medical College (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the renewal permission is granted for all India quota.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under IMC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of MCI and the Central/State Government.
