9th Annual UP-UK APPICON 2019

The 9th Annual UP-UK conference of the Association of Physiologists and Pharmacologists of India was organized jointly by the Departments of Physiology and Pharmacology on 5th and 6th of April 2019. 


Dr.Nirupma Gupta was the convener for the event. Dr. Dinesh Kumar, Professor,




World Leprosy Day


