World ORS Day

Department of Community Medicine along with department of Pediatrics observed the World ORS Day on 30th June, 2019. Community Medicine department arranged a health talk in RHTC to spread awareness among the people regarding ORS and its benefits on 30 June 2019. The Health Talk was planned and coordinated by Dr Khushboo Juneja, Dr Ambren Chauhan, Dr Anjani Kumar Srivastava, Dr Tuhina Shree, LMO Dr Sushila Verma of Department of Community Medicine under the guidance of Dr S Nagesh (Professor & Head) and Dr Amit Singh Pawaiya (Associate Professor).

The day started with a health talk given by interns Anjali Saroha, Priyam, Sanjukta and Imzah Parvez in RHTC in which the people were made aware of Health related problems occurring in the area due to diarrhoea and also dehydration caused by it. They were also told about correct way of making ORS and how to use ORS along with benefits of zinc tablets. Following the talk general physical health examination and systemic examination was done by the doctors and medical students and free ORS sachets were given to all adults as well as children. A proforma was filled by every villager present in the RHTC. Overall it was very successful event due to the combined efforts of the Department of Community medicine, Interns and staff of RHTC.



School Camp in collaboration with Inner Wheel Club

Department of Community Medicine arranged a camp in school for the assessment and monitoring of health-related problems in school going children and general health check-up on 2nd August 2019. The camp was planned and coordinated by Dr Amit Singh Pawaiya, Dr Khushboo Juneja, Dr Ambren Chauhan and Dr Sushila Verma, Department of Community Medicine under the guidance of Professor Dr S Nagesh (HOD).

The day started with a health talk given by the Interns i.e, Anjali Saroha, Sanjukta and Imzah Parvez in Prathmik Vidyalaya at Rauni in which the people were made aware of Health-related problems in school going children. Following the talk, general physical health examination including dental and ophthalmic examination was done by the doctors and the interns. A proforma was filled by every student in the school in the required age group. Their heights and weights were measured, vision and hearing were tested and hygiene of all the students was





checked. Based on it, appropriate advice and suggestions were given. Free toothbrushes and toothpastes were provided to the children on the basis of dental check-up. At the end of health check-up, a nukkad natak was performed by NSS Students on ORS telling about the uses and benefits of ORS. Overall the camp was very successful due to the combined efforts of the Department of Community medicine, Interns and staff of RHTC.

First Foundation Course for the New Batch admitted in 1st MBBS was held from 1st to 31st of August, 2019, as per the new Guidelines of MCI organised by the Medical Education Unit and Foundation committee of SMS&R. Prof Ashok Bhatnagar, Head MEU was In-charge and coordinator of the Foundation Course. The MEU and first MBBS faculty Members were Co-Coordinator of the Foundation course.



It was a great challenge to organise such a long duration course for a month without teaching first MBBS subjects. It took almost two months to formulate the entire one-month schedule after lots of discussions and deliberations to give the final shape to the Foundation course. Almost 100 classes had to be arranged which were taken by more than 60 Teaching Faculty Members of SMS&R and other institutions of Sharda University. The month long Foundation course included 30 hrs duration Orientation course for first five days which started with the grand inauguration on day one. After this the course contents were divided according to the dedicated hours allotted as per MCI guidelines-35 hrs for Skills module, 40 hrs for Professional and Ethics, 40 hrs for Language and Computers, 22 hrs for Sports and Extracurricular activities and 8 hrs for the Field visit.

The students entering Medical Colleges are from different backgrounds and have different expectations. They are plagued by personal fears of home sickness, peer pressure, ragging, language and other adjustment problems at 17-19 years of impressionable age. Besides there is a need to appreciate the nature of their chosen profession.

MCI has set clear regulations regarding the crucial foundation course to shape them into model Doctors. The Aim was to sensitize the fresh Medical Students with the required skills and knowledge which would help them to acclimatise to the new professional environment and would also help in future during their long career of Medical Profession. The intent was to provide a bridge course for students from different boards, language of instructions, backgrounds and cultures and adequately prepare them for learning and a career in medicine

Closing Ceremony was organised on the last day, 31st August. It was attended by the Dean and other faculty members and the new students.
