NEWS & EVENTS

National Nutrition Week (01/09/2019 to 07/09/2019)

The National Nutrition Week was celebrated from 1st to 9th September, 2019. Various activities were held during the week. A guest lecture was organized on 6th September, 2019 at the 5th floor, auditorium, SMSR. Welcome Address was given by Dr S Nagesh (Professor & HOD, Department of Community Medicine) and guest speakers were introduced by Dr. Khushboo Juneja (Assistant Professor, Department of Community Medicine).

First guest speaker was Ms Mili Asrani (Food Technologist, United Nations- World Food Programme, New Delhi) who sensitized the students, residents and faculty members on topic “Fortification as a strategy to address Anaemia”. Another Guest lecture was delivered by

Dr Praveen Kumar (Professor, Paediatric department, UCMS, New Delhi) on topic “Mission: Poshan Abhiyan”.

Activities at UHTC (Bhangel) and RHTC (Panchaytan)

Activities were planned and co-ordinated by UHTC in-charge: Dr. Neha Tyagi, Dr. Anshu Singh and Dr. Neeti Purwar and RHTC in-charge: Dr. Amit Singh Pawaiya, Dr. Khushboo Juneja and Dr. Ambren Chauhan under the guidance of Dr. S. Nagesh and Dr. Shalini Srivastava.

Specialist OPD for under-five children by Department of Pediatrics was held at RHTC, Panchaytan on 2nd September and UHTC, Bhangel on 4th September, 2019 by Dr Garima, Dr Parina (Post graduate students) and Savita (Child Counsellor).

Swachhata hi Seva Abhiyan (1st October 2019)

Department of Community Medicine, SMS&R, arranged a health talk in RHTC Panchaytan to spread awareness among the people on 1st October on Swachhata hi seva campaign and the main motto of this health talk was to convey to the general public to say no to single used plastic. The Health Talk was planned and coordinated by Dr. Khushboo Juneja, Dr. Ambren Chauhan, LMO Dr. Sushila Verma of Department of Community medicine under the guidance of professor Dr. S Nagesh, HOD and Dr. Amit Singh Pawaiya, Associate professor .

World Obesity Day (11 October 2019)

A Guest lecture was organized by the Department of Community Medicine conducted on the topic "Recent updates in Epidemiology of Obesity and the National Health Program" which was delivered by Dr Rinku Sharma, MCDC. Vote of thanks was presented by Dr. Anjani Kr. Srivastava,



Assistant Professor. MBBS students from 7th semester (2016-17 batch), post-graduate students and faculty from different departments attended the guest lectures.

Activities at UHTC (Bhangel) and RHTC (Panchaytan):

Health screening camp was organized at Gheja village in Bhangel UHTC and Masoda village in panchaytan RHTC where people above 30 years of age were screened for any non-communicable disease. The blood pressure, height and weight were measured and the BMI was calculated to assess the risk of hypertension & obesity in the population. Total 38 patients at Gheja and 34 patients in Masoda were screened for NCDs. High risk patients were referred to the UHTC and RHTC for further work up and investigations. During the camp health awareness sessions on "Obesity and its hazards" were conducted at UHTC Bhangel by Dr. Neeti purwar and at RHTC Panchaytan by Dr Ambren Chauhan.



Breast Cancer Screening Camp (21-10-2019 & 22-10-2019)

Activities at RHTC (Panchaytan)

Activities were planned and coordinated by RHTC in-charge: Dr. Amit Singh Pawaiya, Dr. Khushboo Juneja and Dr. Ambren Chauhan under the guidance of Dr. S. Nagesh, Dr. Shalini Srivastava, Dr. Harsh Mahajan and Dr. Nazrul in association with Rotary Club.

Venue for screening camp was Sharda Clinic, Kasna Road, Dankaur Block, Panchaytan. List of females for breast cancer screening was made with the help of LMO (Dr Susheela), interns posted at RHTC (Chanchal, Anjali, Ankita, Diksha, Akansha, Roshni and Mohit), Mr Alok (MSW) and Mr Naresh (MSW). Females above 35 years of age were called for breast cancer screening camp.



Activities at UHTC (Bhangel)

Activities were planned and coordinated by UHTC in-charge: Dr. Neha Tyagi, Dr. Anshu Singh and Dr. Neeti Purwar under the guidance of Dr. S. Nagesh, Dr. Shalini Srivastava and Dr. Nazrul in association with Rotary Club. Mammography van from Sharda Hospital was parked near the community health center, Bhangel. List of females for breast cancer screening was made with the help of LMO (Dr Neha Palo), Mr Manoj (MSW) and Mr Bhoop Singh (Health Educator). Females above 40 years of age were called for breast cancer screening camp. This was followed by sensitisation of females regarding breast self-examination by interns posted at UHTC (Har Simran Kaur, Rashi Sharma, Rashi Dayal, Isha Juneja, Shreya and Jyoti).



World Polio Day (24-10-2019)

A CME was organized by the Departments of Paediatrics and Community Medicine. Guest lecture was delivered by the guest speaker Dr. Sanjay Chaturvedi, Prof and HOD, Paediatrics, UCMS, Delhi. The topic of the guest lecture was "Sustaining Polio Free India". Students from 7th semester (2016-17 batch), post-graduate students and faculty from different departments attended the guest lecture.

Health Awareness session at RHTC and UHTC

At RHTC a health talk on 'World Polio Day' by interns (Ms Chanchal, Ms Ankita, Ms Anjali, Ms Akansha, Ms Roshini, Mr Mohit) was given to



villagers followed by question answer session. Emphasis was given on Polio transmission and prevention. Dr. Ambren Chauhan told about the services and vaccines available at the centre.

Similarly, awareness session was held at UHTC. The team to bring the plans into action included Dr Tuhina, medico social workers, interns and the office staff. Health talk to community members was given by interns (Ms Rashmi, Ms Jyoti and Ms Harsimran). A question answer session was conducted by Dr Anshu Singh in which the people of the community actively participated and cleared their myths and doubts regarding Polio and other vaccines as well. It generated a great impact on the people's mind and they took keen interest in the awareness talk. Mr Manoj, MSW told about the immunization day, vaccines and services available at UHTC.



School Health Programme (02-11-2019)

A School health programme was held by SNSR along with the Department of Community Medicine, SMSR for assessing the body mass index (BMI) of the students of Delhi World Public School, Greater Noida, to celebrate world obesity day. The program was started at 10am with recording of height, weight and BMI of the children. BMI card was provided to the children of 6th, 7th, 8th, and 9th standard.



Iron Deficiency Day (22-11-2019 to 25-11-2019)

Activities at RHTC (Panchaytan) and UHTC (Bhangel)

Activities were planned and co-ordinated by RHTC in-charge: Dr. Amit Singh Pawaiya, Dr. Khushboo Juneja and Dr. Ambren Chauhan and UHTC in-charge: Dr. Neha Tyagi, Dr. Anshu Singh and Dr. Neeti Purwar under the guidance of Dr. S. Nagesh , Dr. Shalini Srivastava & Dr. Harsh Mahajan. Nutritional deficiency screening camp was conducted among school going adolescent girls. The students were screened for anaemia and the identified anaemic students (RHTC- 54 students & UHTC- 63 students) were distributed iron-folic acid (IFA) tablets under Community Connect Program.



Health Awareness sessions at UHTC (Bhangel) and RHTC (Panchaytan) were conducted in the community and a health talk was given by interns on the topic - Serious public health problems posed by Iron Deficiency Anaemia.

Radio Talk on Suno Sharda at 90.8 FM: A talk was conducted by Dr Ishaprasad Bhagwat (Program Manager, The India Nutrition Initiative, TATA trusts) and expert advice was given on “How to combat Anaemia” on Suno Sharda.



Model making competition on the topic: Nutritional Deficiency disorders was also held which was judged by Dr. Ishaprasad Bhagwat, Dr. Pooja Rastogi (Associate Dean), Dr. Nimmi Chautani (HOD & Prof., Dept. of OBS and GYN) and Dr. Renu Dutta (HOD & Prof, Dept. of Microbiology). Miss Poorva Divoliya, Miss Shreyasi Seth and Miss Indu Singh were declared as winners.

Dr Ishaprasad Bhagwat also delivered a guest lecture on the topic: An Anaemia Mukht Bharat : How Can we make it a reality. Students from 7th semester, post-graduate students, BPT students and faculty from different departments attended the CME.
